



Warrington Gold Coast Mini Tennis Year 5/6 Festival

Mini Tennis Competition Information

Teams

- A team will be made up of two boys and two girls from years 5 and / or 6
- Both club and non-club tennis players are eligible to enter
- Teams will be split into 4 groups – 2 in each sportshall
- Teams will play against all other teams in their pool, with the winning team from each pool playing off in a final, to determine the overall winner of each group.
- Each team is asked to nominate 'Boy 1', 'Boy 2', 'Girl 1' and 'Girl 2'. In each match, players will play against their opposite player

Matches

- Mini Tennis scoring does not use traditional tennis scoring (15, 30, 40 etc). Instead, simple numbered scoring is used, i.e. 1, 2, 3, 4 etc
- Matches will take place on a Badminton court
- Matches will play to an agreed number depending on number of teams.
- Each 'match' is set off to play and the final score is recorded. All of the points from the matches are added together to come up with a cumulative team score. Wins and losses are not recorded
- Only players, competition staff and 1 member of staff from each school (if needed) are allowed on court during play
- The Tournament Referees decision is final
- Sponge Balls are used
