SEND pupils

-3 x Ability Days

Each day is a multi-sports event, specifically for SEND pupils, with additional CPD given to staff in attendance.

The aim is to give young people with special educational needs - from mainstream and special schools in the Warrington area - the opportunity to take part in appropriate physical activities that could lead them to partake in competitive opportunities on the day and at future events.

Curriculum Enrichment

- **Playground Leader training**

- 2 hours positive play training for selected young Playground Leaders (usually year 5/6).

- **MDA Training**

- 2 hours training for MDAs to support Leaders on the playground. (Initial training resource is at an additional cost, but for an update of MDA training there is no cost. This is followed by a further session involving Playground Leaders and MDAs together.)

- **Equipment Loan Service**

- WaSSP has equipment that can be loaned to schools which is listed on our website: <https://www.wassp.co.uk/membership-benefits/equipment-loan>

- **Co-ordinated, free, shared transport for county School Games Finals outside of Warrington.**

- **Access to a supported PE Apprentice scheme**

- This is available at an additional cost and is led jointly by WaSSP and Fit Training.

- **FA KS1 Active Literacy course**

- Bringing stories to life through creative physical activity to engage children further in healthy active lifestyles.

Gifted & Talented Holiday Camps

- 3 Day G&T Holiday Camp (February half term). The G&T Multi-skills Academy is designed to enhance and enrich the current provision in Key Stage 2 and focuses on achieving the following:
 - the acquisition and mastery of generic skills that are useful for all activity
 - helping children understand the benefits of physical activity
 - helping children find and fulfil their future potential

Our coaches will deliver activities based around the development of skills such as hand-eye coordination, strength, running, striking, balance, agility, power, kicking, jumping, leaping and catching.

The Multi-skill Academy forms part of the Warrington Performance Pathway for young people which helps bridge the gap to National Governing Bodies Player Pathways. This programme is on a nomination basis only and more information will be sent to member schools throughout the year.

Primary Leadership Holiday Camps

- 3 Day Leadership Camps (during October, Easter and summer holidays)

For pupils with an interest in:

- Sports Leadership using relevant School Games sports in a practical situation but through officiating
- Coaching and event organisation

They can then come back and support relevant sports for that term, all leading to competitions.

Warrington School Games

This is a nationally funded programme to inspire millions of young people across the country to take part in appropriate, competitive school sport.

Lymm High School & Beamont Collegiate Academy receive funding for 3 days a week to manage the programme across the 90 educational establishments in Warrington. Funding is used to pay the salaries of each School Games Lead only.

A contribution of the SLA is towards School Games, covering the costs of medals, venues, certificates, transport and additional staffing needed to continue offering the extensive programme.

Higher KPI's guide School Games Leads in the delivery of the School Games Programme and dictate the delivery of a minimum of 22 primary and secondary school events throughout each academic year, split between pathway, developmental and festival events.

Warrington Wolves

Sky Try is an initiative launched in conjunction with Super League Clubs and Sky TV to develop Rugby League at grass roots level, by encouraging more people to play Rugby League more often.

The Sky Try initiative enables us to offer FREE coaching to all primary schools in Warrington.

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Curriculum Support and After School Clubs

- We are now offering curriculum support lessons to local schools. This is available to all Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 pupils throughout the year.
- All coaches possess the minimum operating standards as identified by the Association for Physical Education (AfPE). Coaches will work alongside class teachers to help build confidence in Rugby League and school sports delivery.
 - Through our delivery, the pupils will develop an understanding of physical literacy, which will help them feel more confident in a wide range of sporting activities throughout school.

Cost per half term (up to 6 weeks):

- Morning or afternoon curriculum support = **£330**
- After school club = **£150**
- Afternoon curriculum support plus an after school club = **£450**



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Year 3 & 4 Sky Try Sessions

- Rugby League coaching for all Year 3 and 4 pupils across all Primary Schools across Warrington.
- These free sessions help your pupils develop the basic skills of Rugby League while introducing them to small games.
- Regular festivals are held for pupils at their local community rugby league clubs.



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Teacher CPD

- A minimum of 2 Primary Teacher Courses per year
- Unlimited places for your teachers and support staff
- Teachers will be up skilled using Rugby League to support PE delivery in school
- Regular staff development will help sustain the impact of your primary School PE and Sport Funding
- Free resource pack developed by the Youth Sports Trust to support your school



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Festivals

We offer a range of Rugby festivals throughout the year for Key Stage 2.

These include:

- Pre-match 7's Competitions for Years 4, 5 & 6
- Year 5 & 6 'Wolfie Challenge Cup'



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What is the SLA?

This Service Level Agreement is a contract between us (the PE & School Sport Team) and the primary schools within the Warrington area. It will run from September 2019 to July 2020.

Why should you buy it?

Our membership continues to provide a high-quality service *to* the primary schools of Warrington, *for* the children of Warrington. We are steered by the PE & Sport Reference Group, which is representative of all physical activity groups in Warrington (including a lead headteacher from each cluster).
